Introduction

WrapApp is a WebFocus based add-on for the rapid development of sophisticated WebFocus self service applications without having to code any HTML or JavaScript.

The product is Object Oriented (OO) and the idea behind it is to reduce significantly the time and effort involved for developing self service applications and offer an easier and more efficient solution with proven ROI.

WrapApp, as its name implies, allows developers to create the self service applications framework from security driven menu trees to sophisticated reusable parameter screens. You can install WrapApp over any existing WebFocus installation fully utilizing your current MRE/BID infrastructure and security.

In addition WrapApp is extremely useful in migrating Focus to WebFocus applications as it bridges the gap between the "Focus" and the "Web" development environments.

Highlights

- Easy and friendly web based interface for developing WebFocus structured ad hoc applications.
- Object Oriented solution for maximum re-usability of form objects
- Data Base Repository based solution – for the easiest and quickest application maintenance and changes (no creation of any static HTML files ...)
- Unified Application styling - Offers smart preconfigured templates that make designing and developing WebFocus applications easy
- Does not require any knowledge in web-based technologies such as HTML or JavaScript
- Allows developers to create complete parameter forms built with reusable dynamic and static objects such as text boxes, list boxes, radio buttons, check boxes, hierarchal trees, text area and tabs.



- Allows developers to easily add sophisticated functionality as triggers, search objects, dependencies and more (leveraging the knowledge of basic WebFocus retrieval and dialogue manager)
- Allows to add client based JavaScript form validations alerts (again, without having to code any JavaScript code !)

Requirements

1. WebFocus 71X or 76X on any platform
2. Access to a relational database (such as MSSQL, DB2, Oracle or Sybase) is recommended for the repository, although use of Focus files is also an option
3. Internet Explorer web browser version 6 or 7
4. CUS (MRE/BID) licensing
